To Whom It May Concern:

Over \$110 million is anticipated to be available from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) for projects submitted during the Call for Projects.

The CWSRF and DWSRF Call for Projects Will Be Open from September 21, 2026 to December 15, 2026

If you have a drinking water or clean water project and are seeking funding during the 2028 state fiscal year (July 1, 2027, through June 30, 2028), this is the time to submit for funding consideration. These are competitive programs. To qualify for a low-interest loan, your project must be ranked and listed on the 2028 Project Priority List developed collaboratively through the Division of Water (DOW).

A Project Profile is Required

To submit a project for inclusion on the Project Priority List please work with your local Area Development District (ADD) to complete or update a Project Profile (and related mapping) in the Water Resource Information System. All information needed by DOW to review and rank potential projects have been incorporated into the Project Profile template. Complete the [CWSRF](#) or [DWSRF](#) template for pre-application and send the information to your local Area Water Management Council (AWMC) before their next meeting. Please ensure that project cost estimates and scheduling have been updated.

Project Profile Must be Approved by the Area Water Management Council

For your project to be included in the Priority List your Project Profile must have AWMC approval. The Project Profile should be updated to include the information necessary to evaluate potential projects. Contact the ADD staff to get your updated profile on the next AWMC meeting agenda. You are strongly encouraged to review the [CWSRF](#) and [DWSRF](#) Priority System Guidance Documents before submitting the Project Profile to improve your project's overall score.

Current Interest Rates

Projected interest rates for the programs will be provided in the 2028 Intended Use Plan (IUP). Rates provided in each IUP are subject to approval by the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA) Board. KIA currently offers three interest rates for the programs. The standard rate of 2.75% is available for borrowers with a median household income (MHI) at or above \$63,726, the MHI of the Commonwealth according to U.S. Census Bureau. A 1.75% rate is offered to borrowers whose MHI is between \$50,982 and \$63,725. The 1.75% rate also applies to those projects that facilitate compliance with an order or judgment addressing environmental non-compliance or those systems that are considered regional providers. To qualify for the 1.00% rate, the borrower must have an MHI at or below \$50,981.
