- Estimated 1999 population of 54,100--34% on public sewer
- Estimated 2020 population of 55,700--38% on public sewer
- Proposed projects would connect about 820 new households to public sewer during 2000-2020
- Estimated funding needs for public sewer 2000-2005--\$5,330,000
- Estimated funding needs for public sewer 2006-2020--\$8,180,000

The region had an estimated population of 54,061 (22,054 households) in 1999 with a projected population of 55,700 (24,300 households) in 2020. Public sewer systems serve 18,500 area residents, or 34 percent of the population. Proposed sewer line extensions for the period 2000-2020 would provide service to an additional 820 households. About 35,600 people in the region currently rely on onsite treatment systems.

Bracken County had an estimated population of 8,280 (3,392 households) in 1999 with a projected population of 8,547 (3,728 households) in 2020. Public sewer is provided to about 30 percent of the county's residents. About 2,400 households in the county use on-site wastewater treatment.

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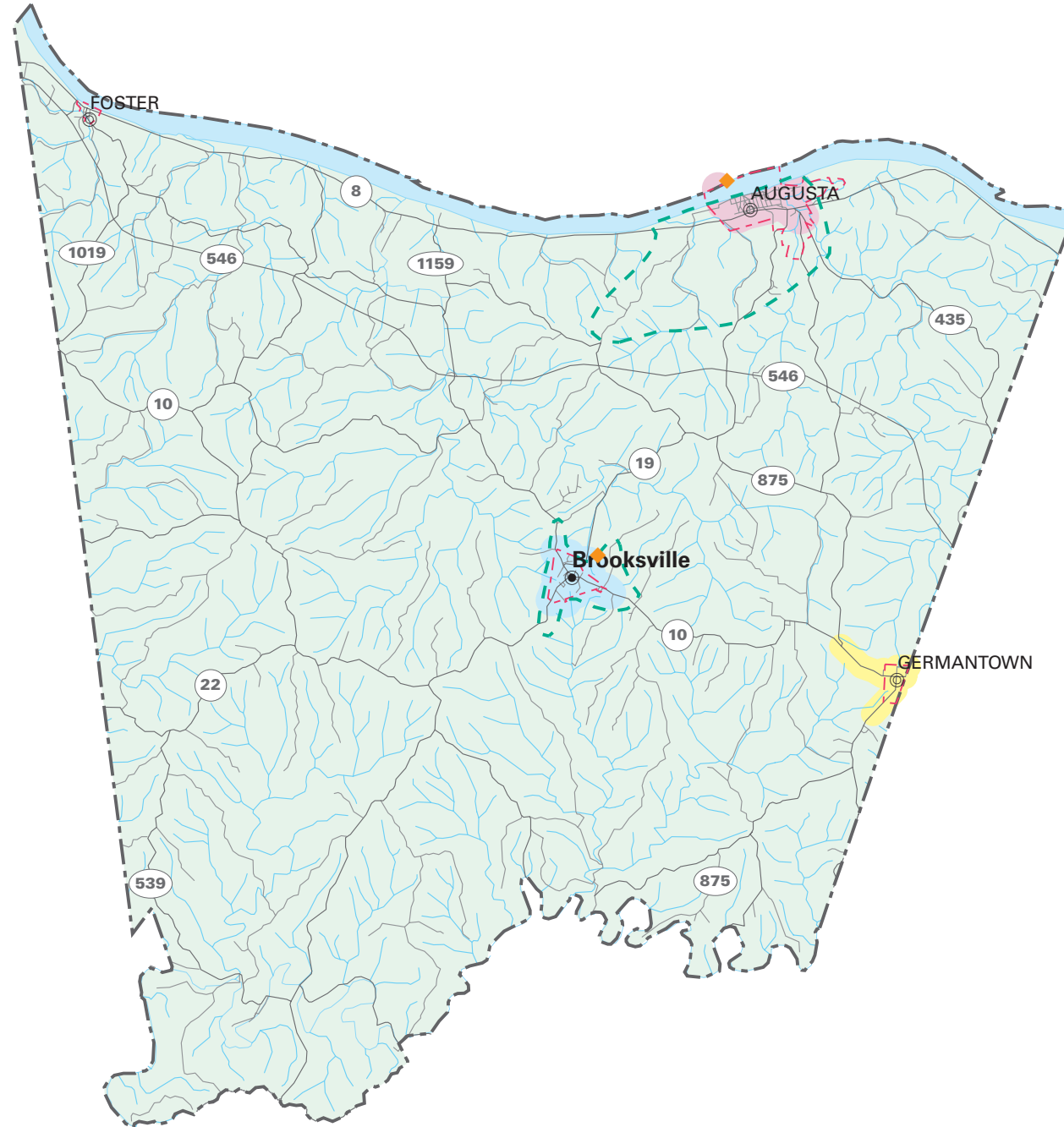
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



Fleming County had an estimated population of 13,289 (5,475 households) in 1999 with a projected population of 14,411 (6,404 households) in 2020. Public sewer is provided to about 30 percent of the county's residents. About 3,800 households in the county use on-site wastewater treatment. About 105 customers could be added to public sewer service through new line extensions in 2000-2020.

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

- Proposed projects would connect about 235 new households to public sewer during 2000-2020
- Estimated funding needs for public sewer 2000-2005--\$0
- Estimated funding needs for public sewer 2006-2020--\$3,420,000

Lewis County had an estimated population of 13,668 (5,398 households) in 1999 with a projected population of 15,073 (6,326 households) in 2020. Public sewer is provided to about 20 percent of the households. About 4,300 households use on-site systems. About 235 customers could be added to public sewer service through new line extensions in 2000-2020.

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

Mason County had an estimated population of 16,661 (6,854 households) in 1999 with a projected population of 15,606 (6,896 households) in 2020. Public sewer is provided to about 55 percent of the county's residents. About 3,100 households in the county use on-site treatment systems. About 480 customers could be added to public sewer service through new line extensions in 2000-2020.

SEWER SERVICE AREAS MASON COUNTY Kentucky



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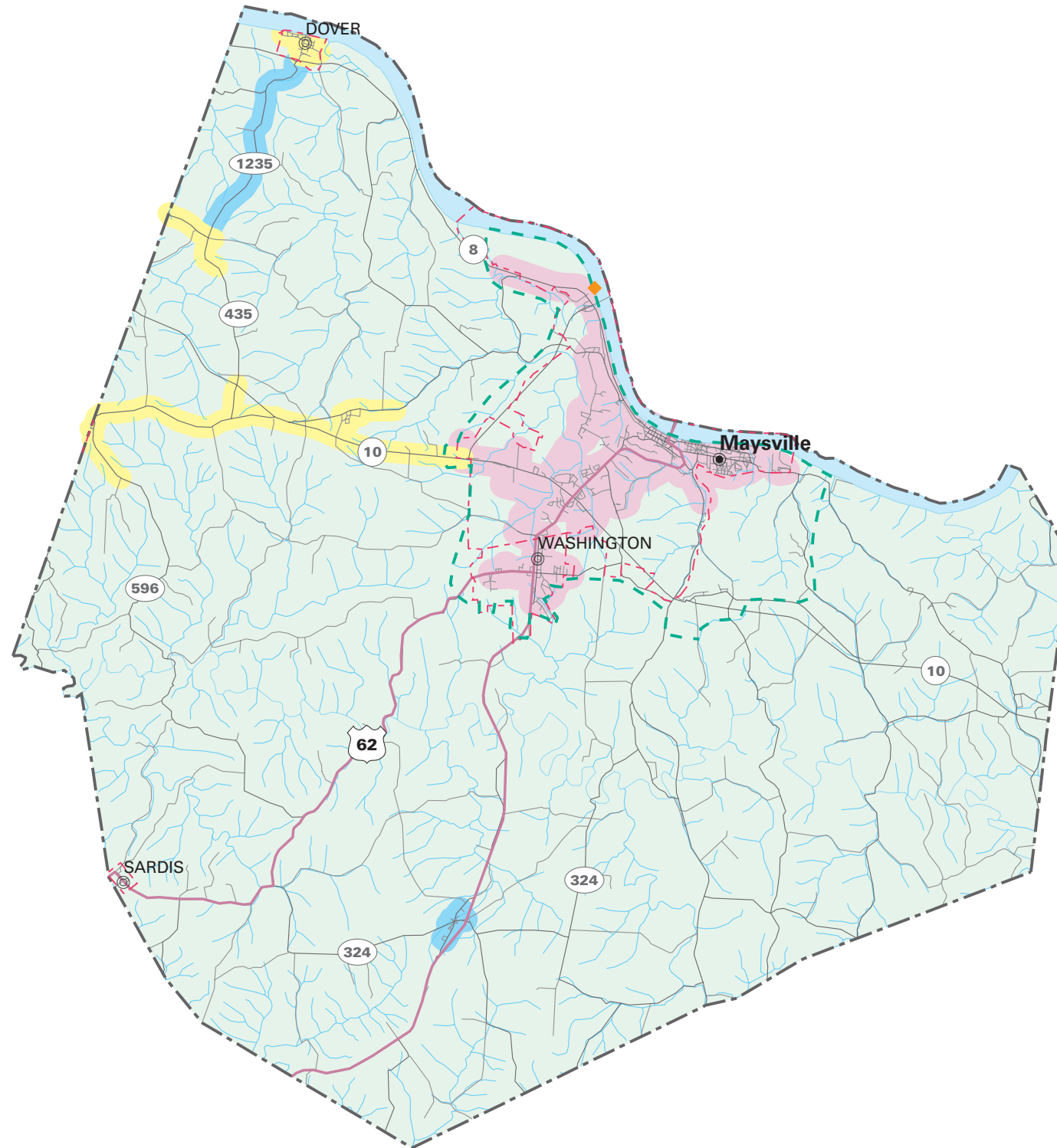

- Proposed projects would connect about 165 new households to public sewer during 2000-2020
- Estimated funding needs for public sewer 2000-2005--\$2,610,000
- Estimated funding needs for public sewer 2006-2020--\$0

Robertson County had an estimated population of 2,162 (935 households) in 1999 with a projected population of 2,027 (931 households) in 2020. Public sewer is provided to about 6 percent of the county's residents. About 880 households treat wastewater on site. About 165 customers could be added to public sewer service through new line extensions in 2000-2020.
