#### A RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A CONDITIONAL COMMITMENT FOR FINANCING FROM THE EMERGENCY KENTUCKY WWATERS FUND (W25-001E) FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$354,899 TO THE CITY OF SALYERSVILLE, KENTUCKY F/B/O SALYERSVILLE WATER WORKS

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (the "Authority") has been duly created as a body corporate and politic constituting a public corporation and a governmental agency of the Commonwealth of Kentucky pursuant to Chapter 224A of the Kentucky Revised Statutes (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, House Bill 563 (the "Bill") of the 2024 General Assembly amended the Act to create the Kentucky Water and Wastewater Assistance for Troubled or Economically Restrained Systems (WWATERS) Program (the "Fund") in order to fund capital and non-capital expenses of public water or wastewater systems that meet the eligibility requirements set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the Authority is duly and legally authorized to make loans and grants to public water or wastewater systems for the purpose of providing funds for capital and non-capital expenses, and in that regard, to enter into Assistance Agreements with such public water or wastewater systems governing the provisions in respect of which such loans and grants are to be made, the amounts thereof and, if applicable, the repayment provisions in respect thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Authority anticipates entering into an Assistance Agreement for financing from the Kentucky WWATERS Program with the City of Salyersville f/b/o Salyersville Water Works; and

#### NOW, THEREFORE, THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS AS ITS DULY AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED GOVERNING BODY, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDER, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> All statements of fact set forth in the preambles to this Resolution and Order are incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth verbatim. All such statements of fact are hereby declared to be true and accurate in all material respects.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Authority hereby determines that the Salyersville Water Works (a) provides public drinking water or wastewater services to ratepayers in the Commonwealth; (b) meets one or more of the eligibility criteria set forth in the Bill; and (c) has expenses relating solely to restoring or avoiding imminent interruption or sewer services after a local state of emergency was declared on June 12, 2024.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Authority hereby authorizes an Emergency Kentucky WWATERS Fund grant in the amount of \$354,899, to the City of Salyersville f/b/o Salyersville Water Works. Upon satisfaction of all conditions of the commitment, execution of an assistance agreement for this grant is authorized. <u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution and Order shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption at a properly held meeting of the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority this 1st day of July, 2024.

#### BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Emergency Kentucky Water and Wastewater Assistance Fund was established to provide funding for troubled or economically restrained systems. The funding is dedicated to capital and non-capital expenses relating to restoring or avoiding imminent interruption of utility service provided by a public water or wastewater system after a declaration of emergency has been declared. The City of Salyersville f/b/o Salyersville Water Works has declared an emergency due to a 14-inch sewer line collapse which allowed raw sewage to run atop the surface and is requesting a grant in the amount of \$354,899 for related expenses. A temporary line has been installed on top of the surface for the sewage to be transported to the WWTP. The City will install 673 LF of 14 inch PVC piping and other appurtenances to replace the line. A notice of the need to revise and resubmit the Corrective Action Plan was sent from the Energy and Environment Cabinet to the City on June 14, 2024.

A RESOLUTION OF THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF OBLIGATIONS OF THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY TO REIMBURSE CAPITAL EXPENDITURES MADE BY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES PURSUANT TO GRANTS OR LOANS MADE BY THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY TO SUCH GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (the "Authority") has heretofore approved the undertaking of the projects described in further detail in <u>Exhibit A</u> (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority anticipates making loans and grants to governmental agencies pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 224A of the Kentucky Revised Statutes (the "Act") for the Project and the governmental agencies may be expected to pay and/or incur costs with respect to the Project ("Prior Capital Expenditures") on or after the date of this resolution and prior to the issuance of the obligations (the "Obligations") which will finance the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board of Directors hereby approves the use of the Obligations to finance the costs of the Project in the maximum principal amount set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u> plus costs of issuance related thereto and amounts required to fund a debt service reserve, if any, and declares its intent that any Prior Capital Expenditures made by the governmental agencies pursuant to loans made by the Authority will be made in anticipation of the issuance of such Obligations to reimburse said Prior Capital Expenditures. This declaration is made pursuant to Treas. Reg. §1.150-2.

**Section 2.** The Executive Director and Treasurer of the Authority are hereby authorized and directed to reimburse, not later than eighteen months after the later of (i) the date of the expenditure or (ii) the date the item was placed in service, but in any event not later than three years after the original expenditure, only those Prior Capital Expenditures made with respect to assets having a reasonably expected economic life of at least one year, and in addition, eligible preliminary expenditures paid and incurred prior to commencement of the Project.

**Section 3.** The Authority finds and determines that, consistent with the Authority's budgetary and financial circumstances, it does not have funds currently available and does not expect to have funds available in the future that may be allocated on a long-term basis, other than the proceeds of the Obligations, to finance the Prior Capital Expenditures.

**Section 4.** The Authority hereby directs the Executive Director, Secretary, and Treasurer to take the following action at the time the Prior Capital Expenditures are reimbursed from proceeds of the Obligations: (i) evidence the reimbursement on the books and records maintained with respect to the Obligations, and (ii) identify either the actual prior expenditure to be reimbursed or, in the case of reimbursement of a fund or account, the fund or account from which the expenditure was paid.

**Section 5.** The books, records and proceedings of the Authority with respect to this resolution shall be made reasonably available by the Authority for its inspection by the general public at the Authority's administrative office every business day during normal business hours commencing no later than 30 days after the passage of this resolution. Said books, record and proceedings of the Authority with respect to this resolution will continue to be reasonably available to the general public until the date of issuance of the Obligations.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption. Passed and adopted this 1st day of July, 2024.
