I. PROCEEDINGS

Commissioner Dennis Keene, called the meeting of the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA) Board to order. He noted that the press notification distribution had been done appropriately and confirmed a quorum was present. Commissioner Keene welcomed new Board member, Mr. David Farrar, representing Kentucky American Water Company, the For-Profit Water Companies.

A. BUSINESS (Board Action Required)

1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

For: KIA Regular Board Meeting of September 23, 2021

Mayor Les Stapleton moved to approve the minutes of the September 23, 2021, regular board meeting. Mr. Ron Lovan seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

B. <u>NEW PROJECTS/ACTION ITEMS</u>

1. A RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONDITIONAL COMMITMENT FOR A FEDERALLY ASSISTED CLEAN WATER REVOLVING FUND A LOAN (A18-028) INCREASE FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$5,360,667 TO THE CITY OF PADUCAH, MCCRACKEN COUNTY, KENTUCKY

Mr. Jory Becker, DOW, and Mr. John Brady, KIA, discussed the City of Paducah's request for a Fund A loan increase of \$750,000 for the Paducah Pump Station #2 (6th Street) Rehabilitation project. The project was initially approved at the April 9, 2018 board meeting. The increase will bring the total KIA loan amount to \$5,360,667. The increase is needed to fund additional costs associated with stabilizing the levee. The contractor ran into an area of unsuitable material when excavating near the pump station wall. While removing the material the levee started to collapse. The area has been stabilized and the contractor will backfill and cap the area.

The project will provide significant rehabilitation to Pump Station #2 located along the floodwall in downtown Paducah. The pumps within this station house 7 individual pumps that are approximately 65 years old and have exceeded their useful life. All 7 pumps, motors, controls, and appurtenances within the pump station will be replaced and/or reconditioned. This is one of several pump stations located along the floodwall in the City that pumps stormwater flow collected from the downtown area to the Ohio River. This pump is the largest and most significant to controlling stormwater flooding.

Mr. Russ Rose moved to approve the Fund A Loan increase (A18-028) in the amount of \$750,000 for a total loan amount up to \$5,360,667 to the City of Paducah with the standard conditions. *Mr.* Bob Amato seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Ms. Linda Bridwell moved to approve the capital reimbursement resolution. Mr. Carey Johnson seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

3. CONSIDERATION OF THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY AUDIT REPORT FOR THE FISCAL YEARS ENDED JUNE 30, 2020 AND 2021

Mr. Allen Norvell, Blue & Co., LLC met with the group to discuss the Audit for the Fiscal Years Ended June 30,2020 and 2021. He noted the following financial highlights:

As of the close of fiscal year 2021, the Authority reported an ending net position of \$1,277,026,000, an increase of \$38,771,000 (3.1%) in comparison with the prior year.

The Authority's total liabilities decreased \$17,115,000 (7.5%) during fiscal year 2021.

The Authority disbursed \$94,306,000 to borrowers for eligible expenditures under loan assistance agreements and \$2,358,000 to local governmental entities for state grants.

Principal in the amount of \$87,029,000 was collected from borrowers for assistance agreements.

There were no findings reported for the year ended June 30, 2021.

II. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Commissioner Keene announced Deputy Executive Director Sandy Williams has been promoted into the Executive Director position. Director Williams addressed the group. On October 14th, KIA held a public meeting for the Intended Use Plan (IUP) for the two federal programs, Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds. No comments were received during that meeting. KIA did receive two written comments during the public comment period, one was an addition error, which has been corrected and the other pertaining to a Planning & Design loan that had not been included, that has since been added and on the list to be funded. The IUPs are now final and are available on the KIA website. The invitation letters will go out after today's Board meeting.

In regards to personnel matters, as previously mentioned, the KIA accounting position has been filled, Mr. Jim Carpenter will be joining the staff on November 16th. He had previously worked at the Auditor's office for 17 years and will be a great addition to our team. Mr. Roger Recktenwald has accepted the position of our Grants Administrator and will be spearheading the Cleaner Water Program funding. Mr. Recktenwald has worked with KIA previously and will be the person to contact with any grant funding questions.

The application deadline for the Cleaner Water Grant funding is November 19th. The Request for Proposals for the Broadband Deployment funding deadline was on October 26th. Thanks again to Finance and Administration Deputy Secretary Geri Grigsby for allowing KIA to run this process through the Office of Procurement Services.

As a reminder, at the KIA Board meeting on Thursday, December 2nd, we will be setting the dates for the 2022 Board meetings, along with the election of our Board officers.

Director Williams gave special thanks to KIA staff members, James Nelson and Denise Pitts for the hard work they put into the audit process. Things went very smoothly.
